As a library partner of the Wisconsin Science Festival, we are asking for your help in a new feedback project - **Statewide Science Stories**! We hope to learn more about what science means to our community and share the artwork of participants in a community art piece on our website.

Included in this packet are coloring sheets for your patrons, a tabletop sign to display, and a return envelope. We invite you to distribute these coloring sheets to your library visitors during their Science in a Bag pick-up window, or as a stand-alone activity, in the hopes they will share their science story and show us what science means to them. Each coloring sheet has a short feedback form on the back for participants to fill out and then return to your library team. Drawings can be whatever participants feel inclined to create!

IMPORTANT: Place all collected feedback in the manila envelope provided to you, with routing label already affixed, and place it in your outgoing red basket, which will be collected by your library delivery courier and delivered to South Central Library System. Be sure to write your library name in the 'from' line on the label.
