

MISSION

The science festival serves as a unique platform promoting collaborative innovation to enrich the next generation of global citizens. The Wisconsin Science Festival is presented by a growing coalition of the science and arts communities from across Wisconsin.

AT A GLANCE

What: First launched in 2011, the Wisconsin Science Festival is a statewide event celebrating curiosity and creativity that brings people across the state in contact with scientists, educators, artists, manufacturers and more. More information can be found at <u>WiSciFest.org</u>

When: Held for one week each fall (October 14-20 2024)

Who: Everyone is invited! The festival includes activities for all ages and interests.

Where: Headquartered at the Discovery Building on UW-Madison campus, though festival events occur throughout Wisconsin in hundreds of communities and in venues ranging from state parks to museums to libraries to pubs.

Cost: Free! Some activities may have a nominal charge for materials or meals, and some partner locations charge their regular admission fees.

REACH

The Wisconsin Science Festival garners widespread media attention, with some events capturing national press. Visitors come to events in Madison and around the state from as many as 17 different states, and the economic impact of the festival typically exceeds \$600K.

- Promote the impact of our state's innovation and creativity.
- Highlight programs, technology, businesses and opportunities from all sectors to communities across Wisconsin.
- Heighten awareness of the fundamental importance of science literacy to our state's economy and foundation.
