8 Fun Strategies to Help Bees Survive

1. Build a pollinator garden

Building a pollinator garden of specific nectar and pollen can help attract bees and provide a place to eat and take shelter.

3. Provide a bee bath

Bees can get very thirsty from collecting all their nectar. Providing a shallow dish with clean water gives bees the opportunity to take a refreshing drink.

5. Plant trees

Trees produce thousands of blossoms filled with nectar when they bloom, providing not just essential food, but also great habitats.

7. Support local beekeepers and organizations

Beekeepers and bee organizations work hard to protect the bees, one way to support them is by buying local honey and beeswax products.

2. Go pesticide free

Use organic products and natural solutions to pests rather than pesticides, fertilizers, and herbicides, which can be harmful to bees' sensitive systems.

4. Become a citizen scientist

Collect data by gathering photos and other information and join a global network on various forums like the iNaturalist app.

6. Build a bee condo

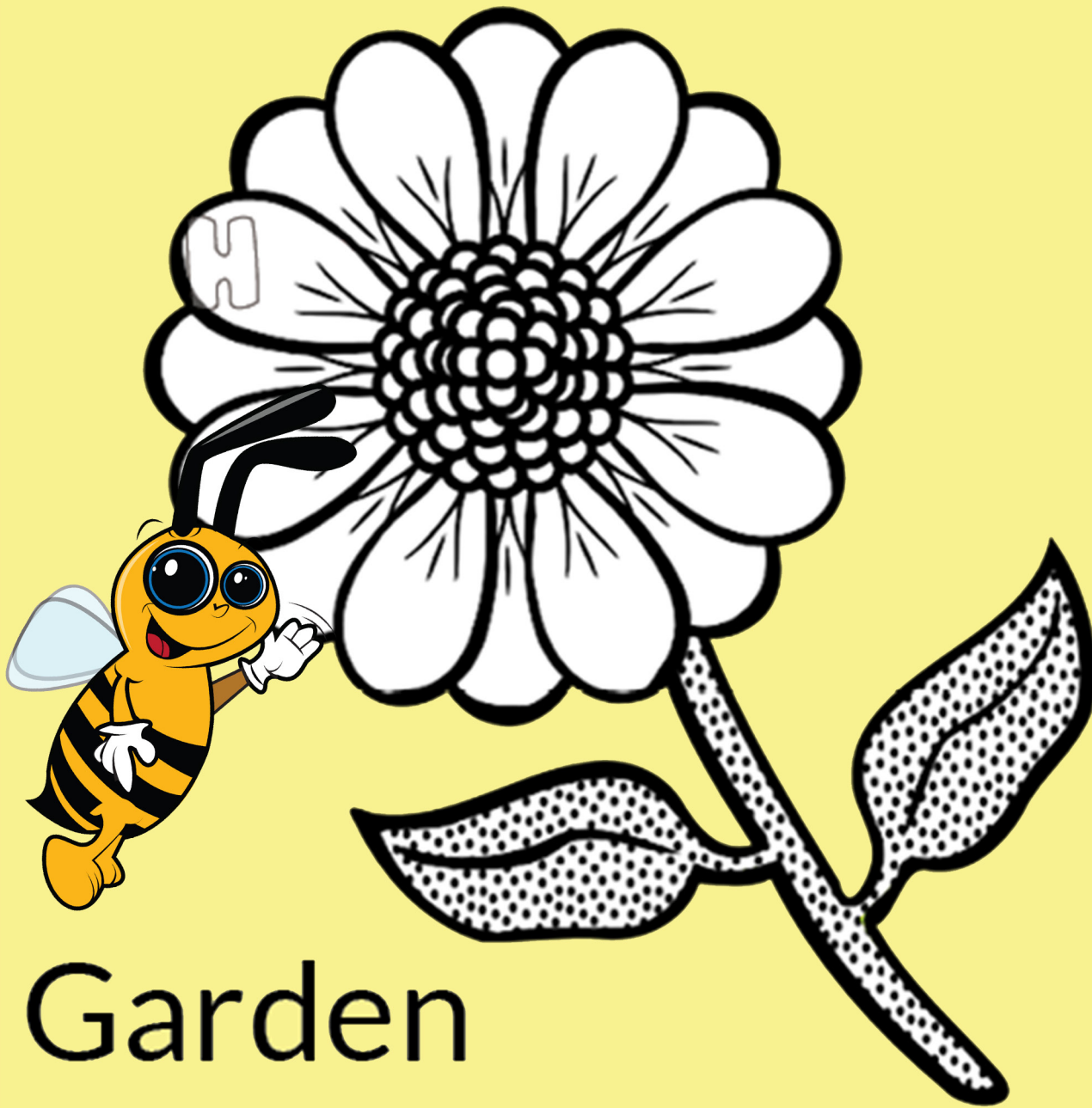
